# Graduation Speeches

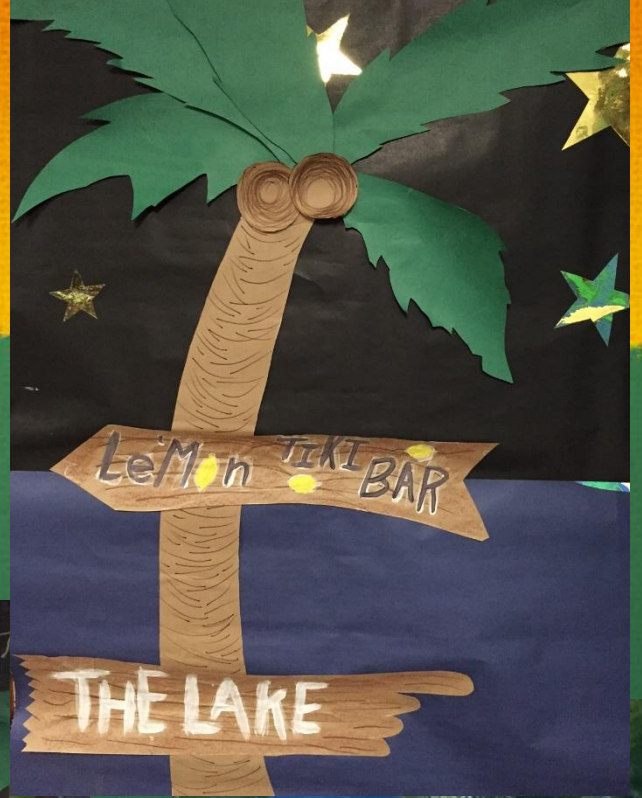
- Speaking at Graduation.
